Reviews and Research Presentation

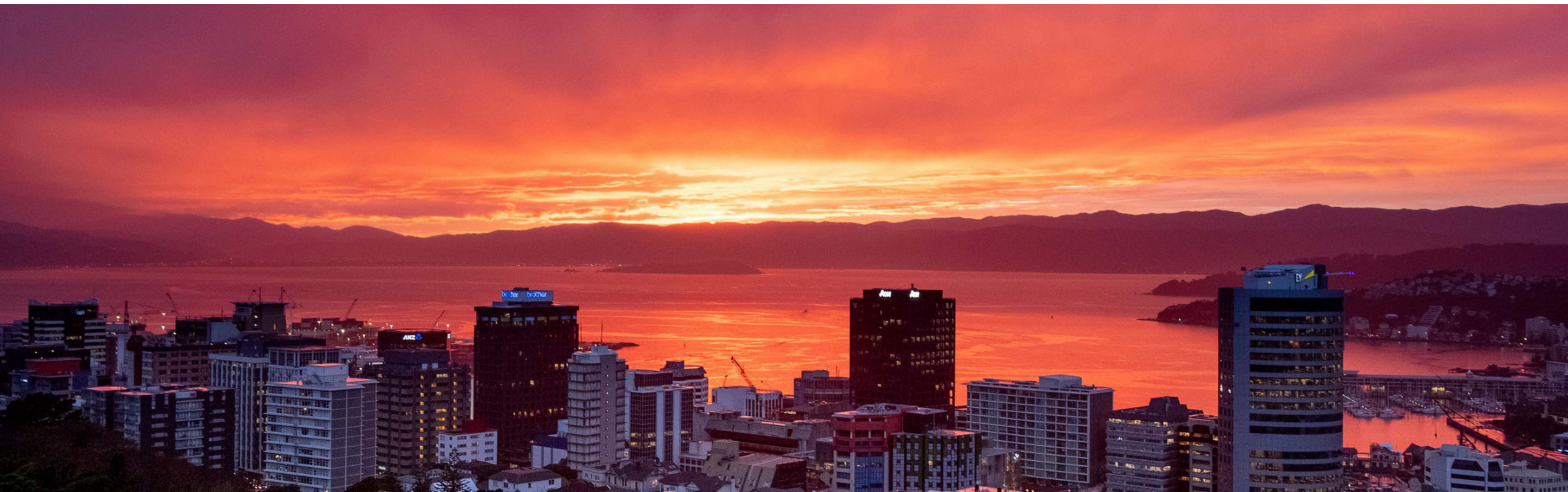
- All paper and poster submissions will undergo double-blind review.
